English: Discussion Texts/ Stories with historical settings

This half term we will be focusing on discussion texts and stories with historical settings. Our chosen story will be War Horse by Michael Morpurgo. We use this to inspire our own work.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be covering work on:

<u>Computing:</u> Digital Imagery / Scratch

In computing we will be looking at patterns in nature and recapping how to take a quality photo. Children will then create a repeating pattern collage of their image. We will become familiar with the Scratch and Scratch Junior programs. We will code the character to move, add backgrounds and audio.

Design Technology: Rationing

This half term we will explore rationing during World War 1. Pupils will learn about the types of rations, the importance of resourcefulness, and then, through practical cooking activities, prepare a simple wartime recipe.

<u>P.S.H.E:</u> Self-care, support and safety - Understanding Privacy

This half term we will discuss the difference between public and private both in the community and online. We will recap esafety and what to do if someone violates privacy.

Curriculum

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History: WW1

This half term we will study the events of World War 1 and the impact this had on Britain. Students will develop their awareness and understanding of the past and take part in a case study researching significant individuals, such as Walter Tull, and discuss their impact on the war effort.

Religious Education: Judaism

As philosophers, we will be learning about Jewish beliefs and will look at Jewish objects that people have at home. We will discuss what the objects are and how they are used. We will look at the story of Passover and how it is celebrated by Jewish people.

Physical Education:

This half term we will be taking part in hockey practicing our ball control, movement, and agility skills. We will learn the rules of hockey and play team games.

Music: Dancing in the Street

This half term we will listen to Motown music, explore musical instruments and continue our progressing our knowledge on rhythm and melody.

Science: Scientists and inventors

As scientists we will research some of the key scientists, inventions, and scientific advancements during World War 1. The focus will be on how science and technology helped soldiers and civilians during the war, while also developing an understanding of the impact of the war on everyday life.
