

**English: There's a snake in my school – Play Scripts**

This half term we will focus on writing play scripts and role play. We will also research the author and create simple fact sheets.

**P.S.H.E: Managing Feelings – Rights and Responsibilities**

This half term we will learn that everyone has rights and responsibilities and how to carry out these responsibilities. Considering what their own rights and responsibilities are at home, and in school.

**Mathematics**

In Maths, we will be covering work on:

- Number & Place Value
- Measure – money
- Statistics

**Computing: Programming**

This half term, we will look at repetition and loops within programming. We will create programs by planning, modifying, and testing commands to create shapes and patterns.

**DT: Global Food**

This half term we will explore foods from around the world. We will investigate different cultures and even get a chance to make something!



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**Geography: Map Reading**

This half term we will look at different maps and compare them. We will learn how to draw sketch maps of our local area.

**Religious Education: Christianity**

This half term we will explore different beliefs about God. We will listen to Bible stories, including the Creation story and the ten commandments. We will also discuss what Christian people believe about the Holy Trinity.

**Physical Education: Tennis**

This half term we will take part in a game of tennis and demonstrate sportsmanship. We will learn the basic rules of tennis and how to control a tennis ball and racket, how to pass both forehand and back hand, and how to serve a ball.

**Music: Make You Feel My Love**

This half term we will focus on Adele's 'Make you feel my Love'. We will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose music based on this song, we will also listen and appraise other Pop Ballads.

**Science: Properties and Changes of Materials**

This half term we will explore different materials and look at their uses and their physical properties.
