

English

We will look at biographical and autobiographical writing using the Houdini Box by Brian Selznick as a starting point. We will work on techniques to improve brainstorming, drafting, editing and polishing their writing.

Mathematics

Pupils will continue to develop their knowledge of multiplication and division. We will look at sharing equally and groups of arrays. We will also work on position and direction, the mirroring of shapes and fractions.

Science

Chemistry – pupils will investigate states of matter and will learn about the properties of solids, liquids and gases. Investigating how we evaporate liquids, condense gases and dissolve solids and the changes from each state.

Computing

Pupils will learn to further develop their desktop publishing skills. Learning how we create stop frame animation to create story-based animation. Also learning how to evaluate and improve animation, add music, text and images.

Humanities – History

We will look at the Wright Brothers and the story of their first historic aeroplane flight in 1903, using music and role play to recreate the events of that day. We will study the history of flight and investigate how planes fly.

P.S.H.E – Global Citizenship

Pupils will study the social, environmental and economic actions of people and communities. How decisions can affect different parts of the world. Also, how we use and share the earth's resources fairly.
