

English

Pupils will be developing their understanding of sharing information with others. They will further their skills in creating notes, postcards and letters before writing and sending a card to a classmate in the post.

Mathematics

Pupils will be developing their measuring skills using rulers, tape measures and measuring cylinders. They will develop their understanding of weight when using scales in cooking activities before furthering their knowledge of time.

World Studies - Science

Pupils will be investigating recycling and composting. Pupils will further their knowledge of items that can or cannot be recycled before developing their knowledge of what composting is and which items we can compost.

Computing

Pupils will further their understanding of how technology can be used to keep in touch with other people. Pupils will develop their knowledge of why people keep in touch before using technology to send messages.

Independence Skills

Pupils will be furthering their independence in dressing and undressing. They will develop their understanding of appropriate times to undress as well as which clothes to wear e.g. for different weathers and occasions.

P.S.H.E

Pupils will be developing their understanding of their emotions and those of others. They will develop their emotional vocabulary and create art linked to some of these different emotions.

Religious Education.

Pupils will further their understanding of Islam. They will develop their understanding of how people who follow the Islamic faith pray, where they worship and the festivals they celebrate.

Physical Education

Pupils will navigate ways around a range of circuits, using balls, bean bags, hoops and cones. We will also look at key vocabulary used within our exercises such as heart rate, cool down, stretches and warm ups.

Pupils will develop their communication and interactions skills through tasks including following and giving instructions as well as practising formal greetings and manners, and, informal greetings.
