

### English

The world of advertisement is an interesting and exciting place! Within English this half term, pupils will be constructing persuasive and descriptive pieces including constructing their own newspaper, radio and television advert for a product of their choice. Pupils will also be writing short stories using descriptive writing features such as adjectives, similes, metaphors and emotive language to draw in the reader.

### Mathematics

The pupils have worked their way through the Woodlawn school mathematics curriculum once already this year, we will now be recapping some of those topics including addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and finding percentages and fractions of certain amounts. As we are nearing the summer now the pupils may have dreams of a summer holiday, we will also begin a class project where pupils will create a holiday of a lifetime portfolio where they will use their mathematical skills to identify the best deals, find discounts and find out how much the holiday will cost them in total.

### Science

In this half term pupils will study ecological relationships within nature. In this unit pupils will study a habitat in detail and learn how organisms can be identified, feeding relationships and how communities and environments affect nature. Pupils will also carry out research into environmental changes within habitats and will collect, use and interpret data.

### Computing

Pupils in class 9 will continue to learn about algorithms within computing. And will use scratch online to create their own games and animations after viewing tutorials in how to make characters move, changing the sounds for characters and adding multiple characters.

### Humanities- History

Humanities - we will be looking at hot and cold regions around the world, such as biomes. We will also discuss why plants and animals have adapted to their regions to suit the conditions.

### RE

We will be discussing what miracles are and how they may relate to different religions. These miracles will include any modern miracles or events that have happened in eg. bible (Jesus feeding the 5000). We are also going to look at the differences between miracles, mysteries and magic.

## Term: Spring B

## Class 9 (Tom)

### PSHE

Within PSHE we will revisit techniques pupils can use to improve their resilience. Discuss how to rebuild relationships with those we have hurt or have hurt us.

### PE

In Physical Education this half-term the class will be developing their racket skills. Pupils will be introduced to the sport of Danish Long-ball for the first two weeks before moving on to developing their short tennis skills for another two weeks and for the final two weeks of term, pupils will be participating in traditional tennis.

### Creative- Design and Technology and

#### Art

Pupils will learn about food in art and artists who use food within their art and will create individual pieces of food art. Pieces will include collages of different foods they enjoy, imitations of other artists paintings and drawings of food in art and will take an image of a food sculpture they have created at home to reinterpret in their own way.

### Social Communication

In social communication pupils will be learning about what rights they have and how they can develop good communication between themselves and others. On top of this, pupils will learn about body image, coping with emotions and discussing differences between themselves and others.

### English

Pupils will be asked to bring in a magazine of their own interest and look for the adverts included within them. Pupils will also read a newspaper article on a subject of their choices and answer questions related to the layout and content of the story.

### Mathematics

Pupils will be asked to research a dream holiday destination and find out some prices for the destination. On top of this pupils will also practice their 2,3,4, 5 and 10 times tables at home.

### Science

Pupils will take pictures of or draw a representation of an animal habitat near their home.

### Computing

Pupils will make a poster including all the algorithms they use the most in their home lives.
