

English

This term we will be focusing on creative writing. We will be using animations to inspire writing, such as Space monkey, Little freak and The black hole. We will also explore techniques for writing biographies and look at contemporary fables.

Humanities

In Geography this half term we will be exploring the Middle East. Students will learn about the countries of the area, the physical characteristics and contrasts between rich and poor people living in the area. We will explore farming, oil, mining and cities.

Religious Education.

In RE we will continue to focus on Humanism, and explore the ways humanists deal with moral dilemmas. We will also be looking at humanist ceremonies.

Social Communication-BSL

Class 10 will be continuing their introduction to British Sign Language lessons with Greg.

Mathematics

In Maths, students will develop their understanding of geometry (practicing position and direction). To develop their understanding of measuring we will be focusing on money. Finally, we will look at basic statistical tests.

Science - Chemistry

In Chemistry we will be looking at the properties of materials, to include thermal insulation, electrical and thermal conductivity. Students will use a range of methods for investigating materials' properties.

Computing

The focus will be online safety and digital awareness. We will use resources from the thinkyouknow.co.uk website including games and online safety toolkits to learn more about staying safe online.

P.S.H.E

In PSHE this half term the students will be exploring human rights, which will cover a range of topics relating to equality and justice, such as worker's rights, freedom of expression, the right to a fair trial, and freedom from torture.
