We will take part in different reading activities about the book and create our own world. From this we can use persuasive writing to persuade people to visit our new world.</p>	<p><u>Mathematics</u> In Maths, we will be covering work on:</p> <p>Number and Place Value Addition/Subtraction Geometry Measure</p>	<p><u>Science: Living things and their habitats</u> This half term we will focus on global habitats and what grows/lives in them. We will focus on a local habitat and identify living things. They learn of the similarities and differences between our own communities and those of others.
