## Summer B Curriculum Newsletter

### Group B

#### Community Learning

This half term we will continue to travel in the local area either walking or using public transport. Students will be encouraged to visit local places and shops we have not been to yet. Continuing to make the most of the summer term we will also visit some local parks and incorporate opportunities for sport and games sessions.

#### English

Some pupils will begin to covers the skills and knowledge required for Step up to English Gold and Functional English assessments that are to be undertaken in the next academic year. Others will be working on speaking and listening and presentational skills - they will create and deliver an autobiographical presentation and be involved in several social story discussions.

#### Sport in the Community

This half term students will continue to visit the John Willie Sams Centre in Dudley to use the Gym facilities there. Students will follow an exercise regime tailored to them with the help of staff from the centre. As part of the visit students also have the option to visit the cafe on site to purchase a snack or their lunch. On Fridays students can also choose to swim at one of the local leisure centres. Walking in the local community will also be part of weekly choice to build on fitness and social skills.

#### PSD

This half term students will learn about their individual rights and responsibilities, we will also learn to deal with problems in daily life. Students will also continue to look after the garden space. During our Life Skills sessions we will continue to learn to plan, prepare and cook a range of dishes.

#### Creative / Digital Media/ Photography - Tyne on Your Side Project

This half term students will continue to combine their Creative, Digital Media and Photography skills and will work towards a OCN London Level 1 qualification in Photography and Employability Skills. Students will take part in sessions developing employability skills, interview practice, job searching, building a CV and money advice. They will also plan their social event.

#### Maths

Some pupils will begin preparation for Functional Skills maths assessments to be carried out in the next academic year. Others will be developing knowledge and skills on using maths in real world situations - paying for items in a shop - shopping online - paying bills etc.

#### World Studies

Pupils will learn about and experience religions, worship and festivals. They will study how different religions use and perform worship - the different festivals of the main religions in Britain and possibly visit different places of worship in the local area.

#### Living Independently/Enterprise

Pupils will plan, create and sell items for Father's day including being involved in deciding prices and how to advertise the items. After this pupils will use the Bungalow to develop knowledge on what is required to run a household - what housework needs to be done and how regularly - what items are needed to keep a household clean and safe.
