## Merry Christmas

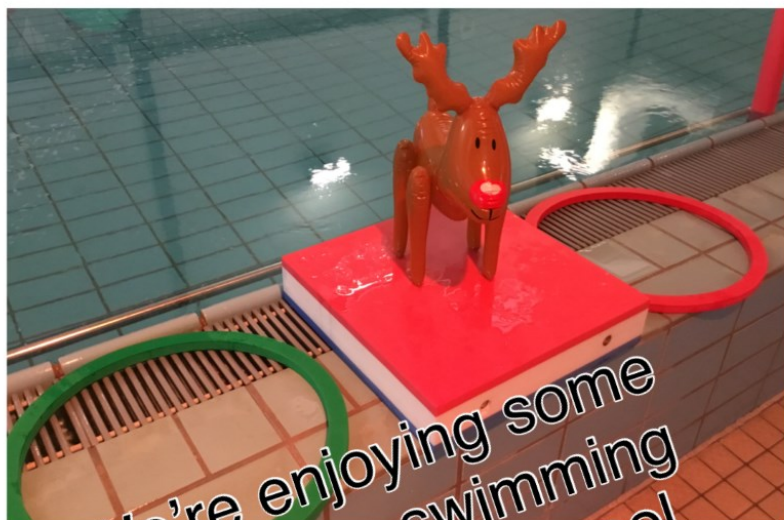
We would like to take this opportunity to wish all of our Woodlawn Community a wonderful Christmas and a restful break.

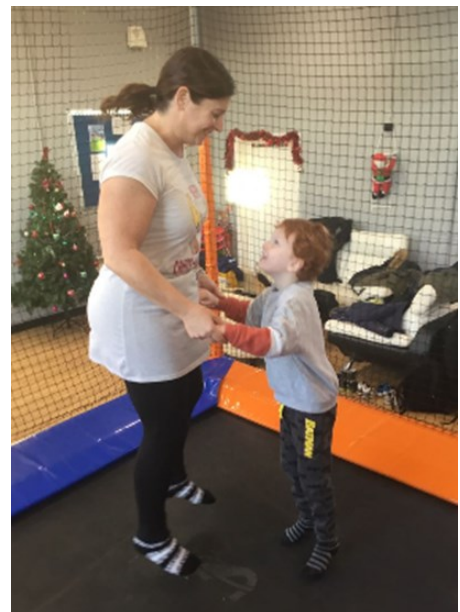
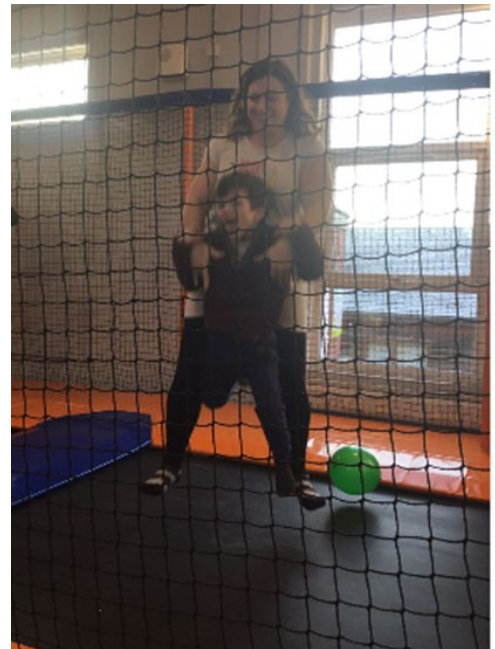
