

English

Pupils will be developing their narrative writing skills using the stimulus of...The mysteries of Harris Burdick. Pupils will compare images from the book, what do these infer, questions the image creates, consider the genre and from this creatively write their own narrative from the chosen image/s.

Mathematics

Pupils will be developing their understanding of place value - recognising numbers, ordering, using greater than/less than, etc. Later we will be further developing pupils' ability to add and subtract using different strategies, then geometry and finally measure.

Science

Pupils will be learning about forces and magnets; types of and how these affect our everyday lives. Pupils will carry out experiments learn more about gravity, air & water resistance, friction and various mechanisms.

Computing

Pupils will be developing the knowledge and understanding of digital media. We will start with online and staying safe. After this will learn about reliability in the digital world. We will learn about copyright and referencing.

Humanities – Geography

We will start the subject learning about coastlines, including waves. Then we will move on to weathering and erosion, finishing the subject on landforms. This will involve some visits out of school to fully immerse the learning.
