

## Secondary Careers

Through the Annual review process, all pupils in Year 9+ receive additional input from Connexions giving impartial advice on next steps – college, work, apprenticeships, etc.

Pupils also have access to days set up by school called 'World of Work' days where employers come in to school and give pupils first-hand knowledge of jobs/careers that might interest them.

Throughout PSHE lessons, pupils also explore different jobs/careers. Pupils will also have the opportunity to explore jobs/careers outside of the school, within our local community.

These can take place through visits to places of work as well as visits from people to our school. Some of the jobs or places of work our pupils explore are:

- The Fire service – Safety Works Newcastle
- The Police - Safety Works Newcastle
- The Ambulance service - Safety Works Newcastle
- Blood bikes
- The Church
- Author – World Book Day
- Charities

- Managing money in Maths, through offsite visits and Enterprise
