

English: Instruction Text

This half term we will explore the book James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl. We will identify the features of an instruction text and create our own set of instructions.

Commando Joes: Levison Wood

During this topic, explorers will undertake a Levison Wood style survival mission based in the Himalayan region of Jammu. They will face deadly creatures, the threat of dehydration and starvation and some seriously powerful forces of nature!

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be covering work on:

Computing: Selection in Quizes

This half term we will develop our knowledge of ‘selection’ by revisiting how ‘conditions’ can be used in programming, and then learning how the ‘if... then... else...’ structure can be used to select different outcomes.

Art: South American Art

This half term we will learn how to make picture puzzles using symbols, make dream catchers, draw an important person, create a collage and make traditional drums to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills.

P.S.H.E: Changing and Growing - Love is All Around Us

This half term we will discuss that as we get older our bodies and feelings change. We will also explore different types of relationships.

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Geography: Energy and the Environment

This half term we will identify features of a settlement, the importance of some basic human needs, about power stations, about the importance of renewable energy, about food miles and about conserving the Earth’s resources.

Religious Education: Reflection

This half term we will reflect on what we have learnt this year. We will learn what a ritual is, the importance of rituals from different religions and how different religions celebrate events to respect religious rituals.

Physical Education: Athletics

This half term we will participate in activities that are involved with running, how to change their speed when moving and how to throw using different techniques.

Music:

This half term we will consolidate the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.

Science: Forces

This half term we will learn about types of forces such as gravity, friction, water resistance and air resistance. We will also learn about the use of mechanisms such as levers, gears and pulleys.
