

English

This term we will be looking at the persuasive language used in many famous speeches. How to use Rhetorical questions, Imperatives, conditional phrases, modal verbs, direct address and how to use punctuation to maximise the desired effect.

Mathematics

Pupils will continue to develop their knowledge of multiplication and division. We will look at sharing equally and groups of arrays. We will also work on geometry (position and direction) money and fractions.

Science - Physics

We will be investigating the effects of light. Carrying out investigations into shadow shape and size and angle of the light source. We will explore the way light beams reflect on plane, concave and convex surfaces and mirrors.

Computing

Pupils will look to further develop their desktop publishing skills. Editing text and images and using templates to create professional looking leaflets, brochures and posters, using a range of different skills across several pieces of software.

Humanities

We will be learning about adventure and exploration. This will cover famous explorers from around the world and the different conditions they had to face during their voyages. We will be looking at maps and how far these explorers travelled to reach their goal.

P.S.H.E

Pupils will support their own and others health and wellbeing by studying concepts of basic First aid. How to call emergency services and how to deal with common injuries, including head injuries. We will also look at burns, scalds and allergies.

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Religious Education.

We will be studying Humanism. Looking at the different ways that humanists view the world, find the truth and decide what to believe. Also how they celebrate different life events.

Physical Education

We will focus on dance sequences inspired by a range of extreme sports, theme park rides, fitness routines and the wonders of the world. We will also explore samba rhythms and steps of the Rio Carnival.

Creative

Pupils will look to create collages using mixed media. We will look at mixed media artworks created by local artists. Also look at the techniques used to create a poly print, linocuts and a concertina book collage.

Social Communication

Lessons will help pupils recognise and understand the causes and effects of stress and learn some techniques for dealing with it. Learning skills for managing stress and make their very own stress ball.
